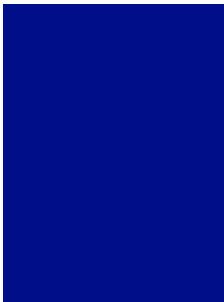


Watercolor Hummingbird Painting

Supply List

1. Phthalo Blue Watercolor Paint (Similar color in Watercolor or Acrylic paint may be substituted)
2. Cadmium Yellow Med Watercolor Paint (Similar color in Watercolor or Acrylic paint may be substituted)
3. Alizarin Crimson Watercolor Paint (Similar color in Watercolor or Acrylic paint may be substituted)
4. Round Watercolor paint brush #10
5. 140 LB Watercolor paper 9x12 (minimum size)
6. Paint Palette (Styrofoam plate may be used)
7. Water container
8. Hummingbird Template



To transfer the Hummingbird to your watercolor paper, you can purchase Tracing Paper or make your own tracing paper.

To make your own Tracing Paper

Print the hummingbird template on standard printing paper. Turn your template face down. Rub a dull, soft pencil tip over the back side of the paper containing the image you wish to trace. Don't cover the entire paper -- focus on the areas where the drawing, text or illustration exists on the other side. Rub the pencil's graphite on heavily; the heavier the pencil layer, the more likely it will transfer. Now center Template on your watercolor paper and with a firm pressure trace the Hummingbird and flower. The resulting image will be light. You can discard the template and then go over the image lightly with your pencil. Any pencil marks visible on your finished painting can be erased once painting is fully dry.
